

Your conference report for our Actuality

The Executive Committee of the German Society for Plant Sciences (DBG) would like the organisers of DBG's sponsored conferences to summarize the event briefly. The article published in our Actuality <https://www.deutsche-botanische-gesellschaft.de/en/actuality> should inform our members and interested parties about your conference.

In order to make the reports interesting from a scientific perspective (and not just tell that the atmosphere was great and the exchange fruitful), reporters should "dare" to define highlights from their point of view.

Contents

In addition to a summary of the topics and contents, it would be nice to provide an assessment of the contents of the conference. The following questions may serve as suggestions:

- What is happening in this subject right now? What is new?
- What was there for the first time (this time), what was special? For example, are the topics / interests / focal points shifting at the moment?
- Were there a conspicuously large number of lectures on a particular topic? Were new theses formulated?
- What did you personally take away as the most important content?
- Was there a highlight? Were common paradigms perhaps overturned because several researchers discussed them at one table?
- What do you get out of the direct exchange with colleagues?
- In what way were early career researchers integrated and / or particularly supported?
- How many participants (from how many countries?) came to the conference and how many of them were researchers at the beginning of their careers?
- What were the titles of the winning posters and talks and what made them special (e.g. ingenious method, amazing results, innovative approaches, forms of presentation)?

Please write your English-language report as comprehensible as possible and send it preferably as a Word document (no pdf please!).

You are welcome to formulate a teaser that will be placed on Actuality's summarizing top page to encourage readers to click it and read your full article. This teaser will also be mentioned in the upcoming DBG newsletter sent to our members. Please also translate this teaser into German language. The editorial office can help you in this.

- Please compose a caption: Who is doing what or what can be seen?
