

Assistant Curator of Neotropical Botany

The Field Museum invites applications for an Assistant Curator of Botany with an emphasis in neotropical vascular plants. The Field Museum's Botany collections are globally and taxonomically extensive with particular strengths in the New World tropics. We seek candidates with a record of scientific achievement in collections-based research, with an emphasis in evolutionary biology such as systematics, comparative morphology, biogeography, phylogenetics, developmental or molecular biology or related fields.

In addition to developing an externally funded research program, responsibilities will include curation of collections, administration, and participation in public exhibit and education programs. Close relationships with local universities allow participation in graduate and undergraduate training. A Ph.D. in a relevant discipline must be held by the start of employment. Applications should include (in pdf format): (1) a Curriculum Vitae; (2) a statement of research interests and career objectives; (3) names and contact information for three people from whom letters of recommendation may be sought; and (4) copies of up to 5 relevant publications.
